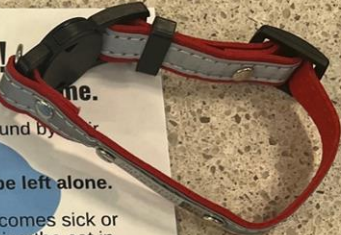

Did you know? Less than 1/3 of lost cats are found by their families at the shelter.


The cat's best chance of getting home is to be left alone.

graph TD; A[Place one of the "Tag You're Home" collars on the cat.] --> B[Hang flyers / place the Found Pet yard sign in your yard.]; B --> C[Ask your neighbors/post in local community groups to see if anyone knows this cat.]; C --> D[You can leave water out but remove food sources to encourage the cat to return home!]; D --> E[If the cat returns without a collar, place the second collar on the cat.]; E --> F[After 5 days, or if the cat returns without a collar for the second time, contact us to bring the cat to the shelter.]; F --> G[Please call us at 703-777-0406 before bringing the cat to the shelter.];
