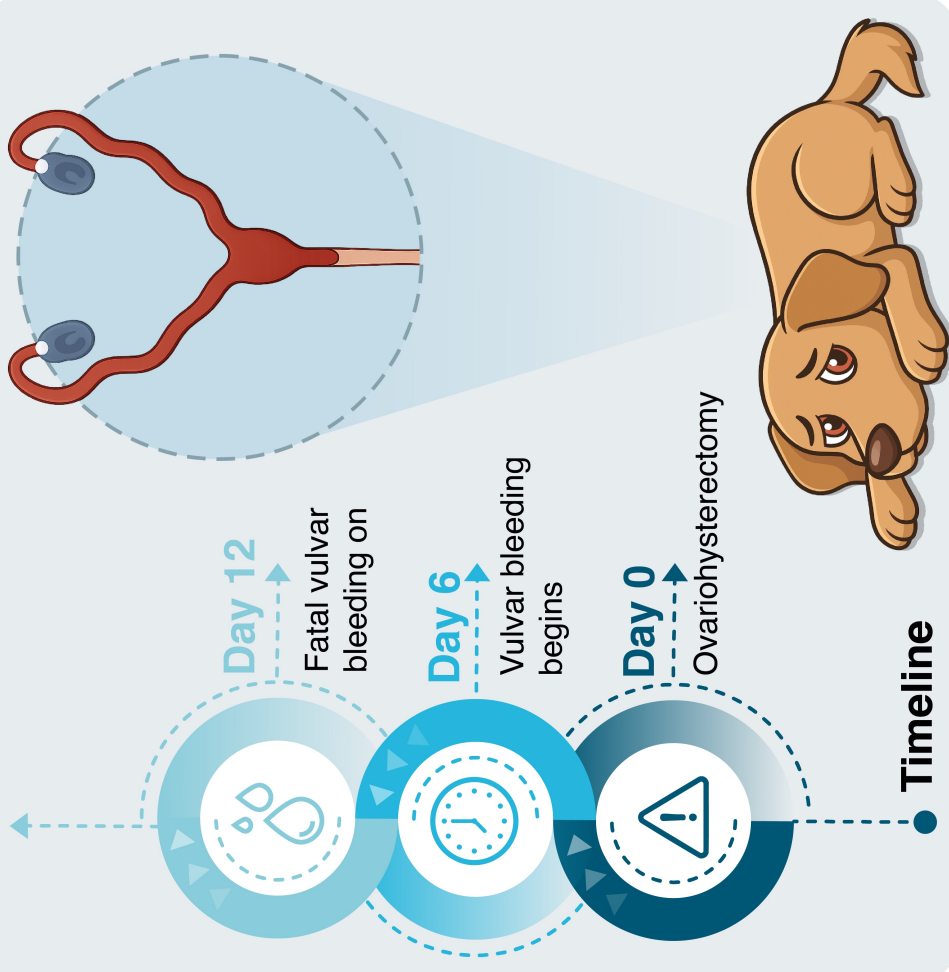
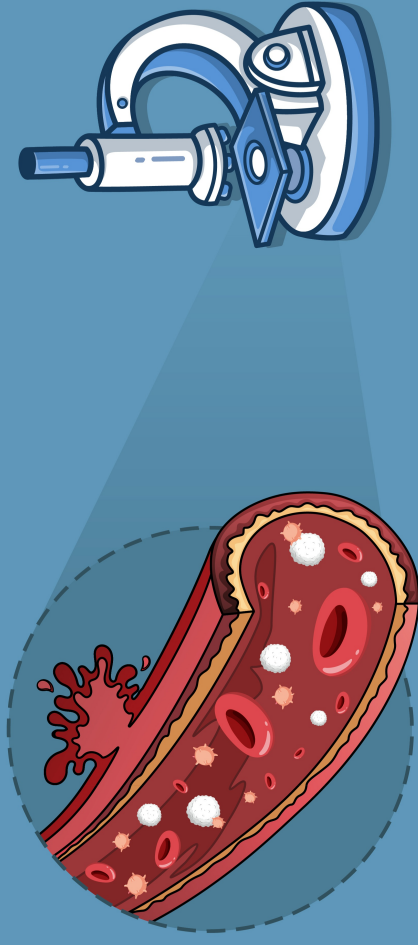


Secondary Vulvar Hemorrhage After Ovariohysterectomy: Case Report of a Poorly Understood Complication



Histopathology

This is the first histopathologic description of this condition. Revealed suppurative and chronic mural inflammation with vascular involvement.



Key Points

- There is a need for greater understanding of processes involved in delayed vulvar bleeding post-ovariohysterectomy.
- Early recognition and prompt surgical intervention may support better patient outcomes in suspected cases of secondary vulvar hemorrhage.
